FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What time is registration for the first day of camp?

- Registration will be from 3:00 – 5:00 PM on Sunday
- Overnight campers register between 3:00 – 4:00 PM
- Commuter campers register between 4:00 – 5:00 PM

2. What time will camp begin each day?

- Sunday – 5:00 PM (right after registration concludes)
- Monday – Thursday: drop-off between 8:30 – 9:00 AM. Camp begins at 9:15 AM.

3. What time can I pick my child up?

- Commuter pick-up Sunday will be at 8:30 PM
- Commuter pick-up Monday-Wednesday will be at 4:30-5:00 PM
- Extended commuter pick-up Monday-Wednesday will be at 8:30 PM. Recommended for all campers 10 years old and above. Wednesday evening is a great night for all campers to stay until 8:30 PM, if possible.
- All campers, pick-up Thursday will be at 11:30 AM. All campers should be picked up by NOON.

4. Where do I pick my child up? Tully Gymnasium

5. Is there an extra charge for my child staying until 8:30 PM?

- There is no additional charge for staying until 8:30 PM. Please inform us when you will be picking your child up for scheduling and team assignment purposes.

6. Can someone other than me pick up my child?

- If someone other than the parent/guardian must pick up the child, let us know at Registration.

7. How does the camp bank work?

- The camp bank is like a debit account. At the beginning of camp, you can deposit any amount of money into your child's account. Your child can use the account throughout the week to purchase snacks and drinks from the camp store. When your child makes a purchase, the amount will be deducted from the total available.
- The camp is not responsible for lost or stolen money unless it is in the camp bank.
- The average camp bank deposit is \$50.
- If your child does not use all of his camp bank money, the remainder will be refunded at the close of camp. If the child spends all of his money, he will not be allowed to purchase more snacks and drinks unless more money is deposited into the camp bank.

8. What do I need to do about medicine for my child who is an overnight camper?

- Please see Amanda Robinson, our athletic trainer on site, at registration

9. Will FSU coaches and players be around during camps?

- FSU players and coaches will be present at most times during the camp.

10. Will there be supervisors at the dorms for overnight campers?

- Yes. Camp staff supervises all campers at all times. Camp staff members stay in the dorms as well.

11. How are campers transported around campus?

- Local, licensed and insured bus drivers transport campers around campus in Leon County School buses.

12. What time will the awards ceremony begin on the last day? Are parents allowed to attend?

- The Awards Ceremony will begin at 11:00 AM on Thursday. Parents are encouraged to attend. Competition FINALS will be going on Thursday morning (feel free to attend all morning), but the Awards Ceremony itself is at 11:00 AM.
